- 四、COVID-19 對全球或區域政治、經濟、文化的衝擊與啟示

- 一、第一階段為摘要審查：敬請於 **109 年 5 月 31 日**前提供摘要。

（一）字數：限 300-500 字。

（二）內容應包含：

1. 研究主題與研究背景
2. 研究問題
3. 研究或分析方法
4. 研究可能的結果或論述
5. 研究的重要性與價值

（三）於 **109 年 6 月 30 日**前通知摘要是否被接受。（論文是否刊登採全文審查制）

Post COVID-19: Social Scientific Reflections and Insights

Objective: As we continue to experience the unprecedented scale and impact of coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic on human beings' health and wellbeing, we, as social science researchers and/or teachers in higher education, would like shoulder the responsibility and push the boundary of knowledge towards the impacts of COVID-19 on our social lives, for example in the fields of human communication, distance learning/remote teaching and language education. Towards this end, this Special Issue would like to invite research-based manuscripts or theory-based commentary papers that address the following issues:

1. Implications arising from COVID-19 pandemic for Computer-Assisted Language Learning (CALL) or Technology-Enhanced Language Learning (TELL) theory and/or practice
2. Implications arising from COVID-19 pandemic for Intercultural Education theory and/or practice
3. Implications arising from COVID-19 pandemic for teaching and researching Intercultural Communicative Competence and foreign language education theory and/or practice in general
4. Implications arising from COVID-19 pandemic for global political, economic and cultural issues

Publication Timeline

Abstracts submission date: by May 31st, 2020

Please submit a 300-500 word abstract. Once the abstract is accepted, the final decision on publication will be dependent on the quality of the manuscript itself, as decided by reviewers and editors. Abstracts should include the following information:

1. a general topic under study and the background information for your research
2. the statement of the problem your research addresses
3. research and/or analytical methods
4. possible findings, results, or arguments
5. significance or implications of your research

Notice of abstracts acceptance date: by June 30th, 2020

Full paper submissions will close for this Special Issue: September 1st, 2020

Publication date: December 25th, 2020
